Course contents:

To develop all language skills combining traditional approach with communication method. Students are acquainted with grammar structures and vocabulary by means of various exercises. Topics for discussion: Leisure, Way of Life, Private Life Topics, Holidays, Describing people, Fame and Wealth, Country and Culture. Grammar: Verb Tenses, Modal Verbs, Comparison of Adjective, etc. Communication situations: greeting, introducing, giving information about oneself, asking for information about others, expressing relations, space orientation verbalization.

- 1. Technology copy, save, delete Ability** - Advantage of modern technology, vocabulary: computers, discussion language, question forms.
- 2. Want it need it, Second conditional** - Save, click, forward, download, send, create... vocabulary: electrical equipment. Grammar: second conditional and first conditional.
- 3. Virus alter, Password ability** - Discussion about computer virus, and how to protect computer.
- 4. Changing weather, The passive** - Discussion about weather, about Venice, about Global warming. Grammar: the passive.
- 5. Dangerous at sea, Saving Jesse Arm** - Discussion about sharks in the sea in a Pensacola and about eight-years-old Jesse's accident.

- 7. Look after yourself, Get healthy** - Discussion about healthy lifestyle, healthy diet etc. Grammar: relative clauses with *who, that, which, whose, where and when*.
- 8. Good news - bad news, Present perfect active and passive** - Discussion about health service in UK, about diseases etc. Grammar: Present perfect simple active and passive for recent events.
- 9. Faking it, Catch me if you can** - Discussion about one of the most famous con artists in history, Frank Abagnale Jr. and about body language.
- 10. Happy ever after, Past perfect** - Discussion about anniversary. Grammar: was/were going to, was/were supposed to.
- 11. The party is over, For better for worse** - Discussion about having a happy marriage.

- 13. All part of the job, Any message** - Imaginary conversation and exercises with a partner and what not to ask in an interview. Grammar: reported speech: sentences.
- 14. Real or imaginary?** - Communication exercises in pairs. Grammar: wishes.
- 15. Undercover, Reported speech** - Discussion about TV drama, about characters (cops) in that show etc., speech exercises
